Let us do some “Clinical Exercise.”

1. Sensation as if --“Floating in Air “.

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2. Loss of Recent Memory-Past event remembers perfectly.

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3. Cannot bear bright light. (photophobia) Dropping of Eyelid- Unilateral

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4. Voice becomes Hoarse, Coarse, Croaky without any apparent cause with Progressive Weight Gain, Frequent mood swings and hair loss esp. eyebrow.

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5. Pain in Epigastrium-Solid Food disagree -Liquid easily passes.

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6. Child-Holds Genitalia and Pain at Belly button.

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7. Patient complains of Vomiting, Fever and Pain in RIF, usually started from Epigastrium. Tenderness at McBurney’s point. Pain aggravates while climbing stairs and Coughing.

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8. While eating, Food Lodges at Epigastrium. Must push down with a sip of liquid.

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9. As soon as, head touches the pillow, coughing starts, Dry spasmodic, Nocturnal cough with voluptuous itching all over body.

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10. Pain at all small joints with Redness, Swelling on Great Toe-Aggravation after Red Meat, Beans and Nuts.

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
